

DemMansay.com has learned that Sen. President Louis Patrick Hill, conspiring with Gov. John DeWolf, have come up with a scheme to force economic hardship onto Reef Broadcasting and to rescue of St. Croix's Roger Morgan by giving the broadcast contract for Senate hearings to Morgan's station.

Sources indicate that DeWolf conspired with Hill, and together they contacted the owners to let them know that a payment was being processed to bail out Morgan. What really stinks about this episode is the fraud being committed, once again, on the people of the Virgin Islands. Hill and his cronies put out a bid for stations to broadcast the Senate hearings. There were only two responses: One from St. Thomas and the other from Reef Broadcasting in St. Croix. Yet, over the Holiday Season, Hill had a letter delivered to Mr. Hugh Pemberton, CEO of Reef Broadcasting (DemMansay.com's 2009 Man of the Year) advising him that the contract was being terminated. Oddly enough, Senator Donastorg signed a 2-year contract with Reef broadcasting at the beginning of the 28th Legislature. What are the grounds for the early termination of the contract? We don't know. Is this another legal decision rendered by DeWolf after consulting with Superior Court Judge-Designee Adam Christian? ...So much for the integrity of the Superior Court bench.
