I am a resident of St. Thomas, Virgin Islands.


I write to make a formal complaint regarding what I believe to be a violation of the election laws of the Virgin Islands. Since you are the Supervisor of Elections I have decided to file my complaint with your office.

For the past seventeen months, Governor DeJongh has been using the above referenced property as his official campaign headquarters on St. Thomas. The property is owned by Margaret Creque. The Virgin Islands Waste Management Authority leases the property from Ms. Creque and has apparently given permission to Governor DeJongh to use the property for the democratic campaign headquarters. Several months ago, a large poster of the Governor and the Lt. Governor was posted indicating that the premises is the Democratic Headquarters of DeJongh/Francis. Several advertised but poorly attended activities have been held at this location.

I respectfully request that you look into this situation to determine if what currently exists is a violation of the election laws of the Virgin Islands. I believe it is. Who is leasing the property from the Virgin Islands Waste Management Authority? Who is paying the rent? Is government funds being used to rent the property? Is it legal for government leased property to be used as the democratic headquarters of Governor

DeJongh? The tenant should be required to produce copies of all payments for rent, as well as a copy of the sublease to the property.


