Thank you for taking time out of your busy schedule to meet with Executive Director Samuel and myself to discuss a proposed contract with the 29th Legislature of the Virgin Islands.

As was stated, due to budgetary constraints, the Legislature of the Virgin Islands is not in a position to enter into a contractual agreement with Reef Broadcasting, Inc. We are, however, aware that Reef Broadcasting, Inc. has indeed carried our committee meetings since the swearing-in of the 29th Legislature to date. We also are in receipt of your invoice for such services, in the amount of \$20,000.

As Mrs. Samuel and I discussed, we are currently negotiating with all our vendors to lower the costs of all outstanding contractual obligations; therefore, we are proposing a counter-offer of \$7,500 for the three month period, which ends March 31, 2011. Thereafter, please consider re-negotiating a month-to-month broadcast contract with the Legislature of the Virgin Islands for an amount to be determined after we have completed an assessment of the services provided by each vendor.

I look forward to continuing our relationship with Reef Broadcasting, Inc. and anticipate working more with you to increase our internet capabilities.
